Introduction

A complex refurbishment of an existing Victorian Hotel in Bournemouth to create a 30 bedroom hotel specifically dedicated to those suffering from cancer and other lifethreatening diseases.

The Construction

The project comprised the complete strip out and extensive refurbishment of the building including all electrical and mechanical services. Remodelling of the original layout was required and extensions added to the property to meet very specific client requirements. The building is located in a conservation area within the Meyrick Estate and the design of the extensions and conservatory areas had to be in keeping with the style of the property.
